### **OKVIR**

SKORO PETNAEST GODINA PO ZAVRŠETKU RATA, SITUACIJA U BOSNI I HERCE-GOVINI SE POGORŠAVA: ZEMLJA JE VRLO PODJELJENA I DO SADA NIJE USPJELA IZGRADITI JEDINSTVENO I STABILNO OKRUŽENJE U KOJEM INSTITUCIJE FUNKCI-ONIŠU. NEDOSTATAK POZITIVNIH PERSPEKTIVA JE ČESTO POVEZANO SA ŠIROKO RASPROSTRANJENOM PASIVNOŠĆU, APATIJOM, I FATALIZMOM U DRUŠTVU.

Naročito je zabrinjavajuća situacija mladih. Po završetku rata oni odrastaju u prostorima koji su podijeljeni između dva konstitutivna entiteta (Federacija Bosne i Hercegovine i Republika Srpska) i distrikta Brčko i/ili prostorima podijeljenih unutar samih entiteta. Zbog toga, omladina iz različitih zajednica nikada nije imala priliku da se susreće i dijeli sadašnjicu. Stanovnici Bosne i Hercegovine ne mogu da se zamisle kao građani iste države, i jedino mogu da se vide i definišu kao članovi jedne od različitih zajednica.

Međutim, u cijeloj Bosni i Hercegovini mogu se naći manji i veći akteri civilnog društva koji se ne slažu sa ovakvom društvenom podjeljenošću, koji odbijaju da svedu Bosnu i Hercegovinu na etničku lekciju i koji također odbijaju široko rasprostranjen fatalistički stav o budućnosti ove zemlje. Svaki dan, oni se bore za razvoj demokratskog, multikulturalnog i građanskog društva u Bosni i Hercegovini. Svugdje u Evropi, kako u sklopu Evropske Unije, tako i u drugim zemljama Balkana, različite NVO dijele jednake vrijednosti i jednako su opredjeljene stvaranju građanskog društva u Bosni i Hercegovini. Međutim, poput svojih kolega u BiH, i oni su često izolovani i međusobno se ne poznaju.

Došlo je vrijeme da se na nekoliko dana okupe sve vodeće snage civilnog društva koji dijele iste vrijednosti. Zajedno sa NVO iz Evrope oni će moći razmijeniti svoja iskustva, iznesu svoje snove i razgovaraju o tome šta očekuju od državnih i međunarodnih institucija koje djeluju u Bosni i Hercegovini. Oni će zajednički pokušati da definišu konkretne aktivnosti za budućnost.

Ovaj forum koji okuplja predstavnike civilnog društva iz Bosne i Hercegovine i inicijative iz čitave Evrope predstavlja prvi korak dugoročnog procesa. Cilj ovog foruma je da ojača i pruži podršku cvilnom društvu Bosne i Hercegovine kako bi ovo civilno društvo postalo ključni faktor njene demokratizacije, ali i da doprinese stvaranju globalnog evropskog civilnog društva.

### **FRAMEWORK**

NEARLY FIFTEEN YEARS AFTER THE END OF THE WAR, THE SITUATION IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA IS GETTING WORSE: THE COUNTRY IS HIGHLY FRAGMENTED AND HAS NOT YET BEEN ABLE TO BUILD BOTH FUNCTIONING INSTITUTIONS AND A SUFFICIENTLY UNIFIED AND STABLE FRAMEWORK. THE MISSING OF POSITIVE PERSPECTIVES IS OFTEN LINKED WITH A WIDESPREAD PASSIVITY, APATHY AND FATALISM IN THE SOCIETY.

Especially preoccupying is the situation of the youngsters. Since the war, they have grown up in spaces that are fragmented between the two constitutive entities (the Federation and the Republika Srpska) and the district of Brčko and/or within the entities themselves. As a consequence, the youth from the different communities has never been able to mix and share a common present. Bosnia and Herzegovina's inhabitants cannot conceive themselves as citizens of the same country and can only see and define themselves as members of one of the different communities.

However, one can find all over Bosnia and Herzegovina small as well as bigger civil society actors who do not agree with this social fragmentation, who refuse to reduce Bosnia and Herzegovina to an ethnic lecture and who also refuse the widespread fatalistic view of the country's future. Every day, they fight for the development of a democratic, intercultural and citizens-based society in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Everywhere in Europe, both within the European Union and in other states from the Balkans, different NGOs share the same values and the same commitment to the birth of a citizens-based society in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Nevertheless, as their Bosnian counterparts, they are often isolated and do not know each other either.

Time has come to gather for several days all these civil society actors who share the same values. Together with the European NGOs involved alongside with them, they will be able to share their experiences, express their dreams and debate on what they are expecting from the national and international institutions involved in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Together, they will work on the definition of concrete actions they want to take together for the future.

This forum, by bringing together civil society actors from all Bosnia and Herzegovina in association with initiatives coming from all over Europe, is conceived as the first step of a long term process. Its aim is to empower and reinforce the civil society of Bosnia and Herzegovina in order to make it a key player in its democratization, and also to contribute to the construction of an overall European civil society.

### PRAKTIČNE INFORMACIJE

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Predviđeni kapacitet foruma je oko stotinu učesnika: oko 60 vodećih predstavnika civilnog društva iz Bosne i Hercegovine i oko 40 predstavnika iz drugih zemalja zapadnog Balkana i Evropske Unije. Učešće na forumu moguće je uz pozivnicu od strane organizatora.

Za učešće na forumu ne plaća se kotizacija. Organizatori preuzimaju na sebe pokrivanje troškova smještaja (smještaj u hotelu i hrana) za sve učesnike – osim smještaja za učesnike iz Sarajeva - i putne troškove za učesnike iz BiH i ostalih balkanskih zemalja.

Održavanje foruma je organizovano u hotelu "Hollywood", u Sarajevu gdje će biti smješteni učesnici koji dolaze izvan Sarajeva. (http://www.hotel-hollywood.com.ba). Dolazak učesnika iz drugih gradova u Sarajevo planiran je u poslijepodnevnim satima 13.aprila, a smještaj je obezbijeđen do petka naveče odnosno subote ujutro. Službeni početak foruma je srijeda, 14.april u 9:30, a završetak 16.aprila u 18:00.

Radni jezici foruma su engleski, bosanski, hrvatski i srpski. Tokom plenarnog dijela i panel diskusija predviđeno je simultano prevođenje.

The forum is thought to gather around 100 participants: around 60 civil society actors from Bosnia and Herzegovina and around 40 from other countries of the Western Balkans and from the European Union. The participation occurs on invitation.

The participation to the forum is free of charge. The organisers are taking in charge the accommodation costs (hotel rooms and food) for all participants – except accommodation for participants from Sarajevo - and the travel costs for the participants from BiH and the other countries from the Balkans.

The forum will take place in Hotel Hollywood in Sarajevo where the participants from outside of Sarajevo will also be hosted (http://www.hotel-hollywood.com.ba). Arrival for participants from outside of Sarajevo is planned for Tuesday 13th April evening and accommodation foreseen until the night of Friday 16th April to Saturday 17th April. The forum will start Wednesday 14th April at 9h30 and finish Friday 16th April at 18h.

The working languages will be English and Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian. A simultaneous translation is foreseen during the plenary and the panel sessions.
